

DATA PROTECTION STATEMENT

1. protection of personal data

We process your personal data exclusively with your consent or for the execution of your mandate or order placed with us for the purposes agreed on, or on another legal basis (within the meaning of the DSGVO (Data Protection Regulation)). We only collect personal data that is required for the execution and processing of our notarial tasks and services rendered or which you have voluntarily provided to us. Regarding the transactions mentioned in Section 36a (1) NO (Notarial Code), (e.g. real estate transactions, company law transactions), special legal obligations according to the NO have to be met when processing personal data, this for the purposes of preventing money laundering and terrorist financing (in particular Sections 36a - 36f NO). The processing of personal data on the basis of the NO for the purposes of preventing money laundering and terrorist financing is considered to be a matter of public interest under the DSGVO.

2. information right and right to delete (person rights)

You have the right to be informed about your stored personal data, its origin and recipients and the purpose of data processing, as well as the right to correct, to object, to transfer, to restrict processing and to block or delete incorrect/improperly processed data. Restrictions may result from the obligation of confidentiality according to Section 37 NO.

You also have the right to revoke any consent given to use your personal data at any time. In order to assert the rights to which you are entitled (information, deletion, correction, objection and/or data transfer¹), please contact the notary's office indicated in the letterhead.

If you are of the opinion that our processing of your personal data violates the applicable data protection laws, or that your data protection rights have been violated by any other means, you have the option of complaining to the competent supervisory authority. In Austria, this is the Data Protection Authority in Vienna

3. use of data - security

Data provided to us will not be processed for purposes other than those agreed upon in the mandate agreement, or to you which you have given your consent, or otherwise in accordance with the provisions of the DSGVO.

This does not include use for statistical purposes, provided that the data provided has been anonymized.

We have taken state of the art organizational and technical precautions to ensure the protection of your personal data (protection against misuse, both from the inside and from the outside (such as through firewalls, encryption, access authorizations, etc.)). However, it cannot be ruled out that, due to errors in data transmission not caused by us, or due to unauthorized access by third parties (hackers, etc.) information can be viewed or used by other persons.

We do not assume any liability for this, provided that this misuse was not culpably caused by us.

4. transfer of data to third parties (transmission)

In principle, we do not make your personal data available to others. However, it may be necessary to forward your data to third parties in order to fulfill your mandate or order, or for legal reasons. These may be courts, authorities, legal representatives or other involved third parties (including order-processors working for us). In this case, the transfer of your data will be carried out exclusively on the basis of the DSGVO (based on your consent, fulfillment of a contract, fulfillment of a legal obligation, etc.). As a civil law notary and within the scope of our notarial activities, we also regularly obtain information about you from third parties.

We also point out that it may be necessary to transfer your personal data to recipients (see above) outside your country. However, we transfer your personal data only and exclusively on the basis of the DSGVO (adequate level of data protection or the setting of measures to ensure that all recipients have an adequate level of data protection).

5. storage / deletion of data

We do not keep your personal data longer than necessary for the purposes for which it is processed. Data will be stored for evidence purposes, considering the periods of limitation or as long as a claim (liability) against us is possible.

6. cookies / web analytics / server log files

Our website uses cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your terminal device with the help of the browser. We use cookies to make our website user-friendly. It is possible that some cookies remain stored on your terminal device until you delete them. Cookies enable us to recognize your browser on your next visit. If you do not wish this, you can set up your browser so that it informs you about the setting of cookies and you allow them individually. If cookies are deactivated, the functionality of our website may be limited.

The provider of this website automatically stores information in so-called server log files, which are automatically transmitted by your browser. This includes your IP address, your browser and language settings, your operating system, your internet service provider, date/time, URL, this in order to optimize our website in terms of user-friendliness and to provide useful information about our services. This data is not merged with personal data sources.
